
Many, many hours of workshop time later, far more bills and new parts than we care to recall, and an exceptionally good but expensive repaint, and this Lotus is now looking resplendent and

As usual, our workshop has hosted a wonderfully varied selection of Morgans over the last few weeks...there's been a 1940s Flat Rad 4/4, serious numbers of 'classic' Morgans, a smattering of

The majority of the work was carrying out routine servicing and MOTs, but we also enjoyed undertaking a number of Morgan upgrade-type projects.

An ever popular upgrade for classic Morgans is fitting SSL front suspension which brings worthwhile improvements to ride comfort and handling and at a little over £1,100 to supply and fit represents good value for money. We are also fitting increasing numbers of the rear SSL suspension kits and although not cheap at around £4,800 this does give the ultimate

Another upgrade for classic Morgans on which we're fielding increasing enquiries, is the fitting of power steering. And one of our recent upgrade projects was installing hydraulic power steering to a 1990s Plus 4. This made the car so much easier to park and manoeuvre at low speed, whilst very importantly still retaining the correct Morgan feel at speed.
