Lotus 340R



Continuing with our occasional newsletter theme of featuring important or unusual models of Morgan and Lotus, we turn this month to the Lotus 340R.

As a car that blurs the line between art and adrenaline, the Lotus 340R is the stuff of dreams. Born in the year 2000 and limited to just 340 units, this road-legal, track-focused marvel is a showcase of Lotus' less-is-more philosophy.

The 340R sheds all the usual expectations of a car. Roof? Nope. Doors? Definitely not. Comfort? It's all about the experience.

The minimalist design pairs perfectly with its superlight weight of under 700kg. Power is courtesy of a Rover K-Series engine, tuned to either 177bhp or 192bhp. And this, when paired with the car's featherweight build, means great performance. Think 0-60 mph in just 4.4 seconds and razor-sharp handling.

The 340R is pure sensory overload. With no roof or doors, you're completely exposed to the elements, which makes every drive feel like an adventure. And its outrageous looks? You don't just arrive in a 340R; you make an entrance.

As you might expect from its rarity and styling, the 340R is a sought after car by enthusiasts and collectors and is a Lotus whose value has appreciated rather nicely over time. Unfortunately for anyone who's keen to own one, they rarely come up for sale.
